A. Curriculum update: *P. Johnson*

Paulette mentioned that there weren't that many courses that did not make it by this year's deadline. She said that the new course approval process has been revised. She will be running a test course through called YODA. She recommends that the objectives on the test course be read. She asked the committee to let her know when they receive this test course. She asked that any issues with Curricunet be sent to her.

A request was made to have the priority one list be sent out in January.

B. Senate Report - Minimum Qualifications and Course Justification: P. Sezzi

Peter mentioned that he has been involved with the local equivalency procedure and looking to see if everyone meets minimum qualifications. He said the current CORs don't list what the minimum qualifications are. Paulette said that she has submitted a request to Curricunet to create a screen in Curricunet to post minimum qualifications for every class. She is requesting that they add a drop down menu or link to State minimum qualifications. -Peter said to expect a list of courses that need to have the minimum qualifications added to them at the next Curriculum Committee meeting. This list will need to be approved by the Curriculum Committee. The list needs to be generated by the departments (ie., Department Chairs). Peter also distributed the resolution passed by senate regarding program discontinuance.

D. SB 1440: J. Ferguson

Jeff mentioned that SB 1440 has been passed. He said it's the legislator's notion of fast tracking to transfer. He recommended that all faculty get on list serve (www.c-id.net) to provide input. He said that what is critical is that the descriptors that have been developed and are being developed are in draft form and need to be reviewed by faculty. He said that what will happen is that through this consultation process of being online the community colleges have more opportunity for input to shape degrees and descriptors than in the past.
