### III. Action/Information/Discussion

## A. <u>Philosophy & General Education Committee Membership (Action) – M.</u> Pauley/G. Arevalo

Mark presented a revised committee membership component for the Philosophy & General Education Committee. He mentioned that the committee should be made up of active members of the Curriculum Committee. The new structure of the committee shall consist of the Faculty Curriculum Co-Chair and Articulation Officer as Co-Chairs, Registrar, and one representative from each division from the Curriculum Committee. A motion to accept the changes was made by Mayo De la Rocha and seconded by Michael Bowen. The changes were approved with two abstentions.

## B. <u>Placement of Schedule-Only Information in Curricunet COR</u> (Information) – M. Bowen

Michael mentioned that as he has been doing tech review of the courses going through the approval process in Curricunet, he has noticed that the additional information included on a small number of courses in Banner is not included in Curricunet. This additional information is usually additional requirements listed that student need to fulfill. He asked for suggestions as to adding this additional information into Curricunet or leaving it as it is.

C. TMC Update/AA-T/AS-T Two-Year Sequence (Information) – G. Arevalo
Gloria attending a Regional Articulation Officer meeting in which the transfer
degrees were discussed. She mentioned that one point that came up was the
usage of the correct name for the transfer degrees. It was discussed that the
exact name on the transfer template needs to be used when creating a
transfer degree. The second point discussed was the discrepancy in the
usage of the TMC templates. It was agreed that the templates that need to be
used are the ones located on the State Chancellor's website. She also
reminded everyone about the two-year sequencing requirement that needs to
be included when submitting the transfer degree paperwork.

## D. <u>COR and Syllabi Request by UC or CSU Update (Information) – G.</u> <u>Arevalo</u>

There's been a discussion system-wide regarding the UCs requesting additional syllabi for CORs. It was discussed that if additional components are being added to a COR there might be a possibility that the UC might request additional information. The areas would be in out-of-class assignments and course objectives. When developing these areas it is important to be very descriptive.

- E. <u>UC Curricular Priorities for Next Year (Information) G. Arevalo</u>

  This year history courses were revised/updated. Next courses in line are counseling and guidance workshop courses.
- F. CSU GE Art 2 Unit Course Removal from GE (Information) G. Arevalo
  The CSU system is looking at removing 2-unit courses that are currently
  transferable. We will need to revise any 2-unit courses that we have and
  resubmit them for approval. CSU will not approve for transfer any 2-unit
  course. This will be discussed at next week's Tech Review meeting.
