# Creating a User


- When you first start using Dragon NaturallySpeaking, you will need to create a user file. This is where Dragon will store and update your speech files. After you train Dragon and use it over time, it will improve its accuracy in recognizing you.

# ***Start Dragon Naturally Speaking***

- Double click on the Dragon Naturally Speaking icon on the desktop. 
- If there isn't a shortcut on the desktop, go to the Start menu, then Programs, and double click on Dragon NaturallySpeaking.
- When Dragon NaturallySpeaking loads, the toolbar appears at the top of the screen.



Then an **Open User** window will appear, if not click on the `NaturallySpeaking` button from the toolbar and choose Open User.



From here click on New


Type in your Name



# Position your headset Click Next




Now, the New User Wizard will get ready to create speech files for you.


The first window is the Volume Check window, which will establish that your voice is being identified by the microphone at a level compatible with the software. Click the Start Volume Check button and read the paragraph provided. When the Volume Check is completed click next.




The Next window is the Start Quality Check Window. You will click the Start Quality Check button and read the paragraph provided. When the Quality Check is completed and you receive a Passed outcome then you will click Finish.




If this is the first time you have used Dragon Naturally Speaking (DNS) then the following General Training will appear.


Understanding  spoken language is something that people often take for granted. Most of us develop the ability to recognize speech when we're very young. We're already experts at speech recognition by the age of three or so.




There will be a short adaptation then the following window will appear, check the Skip this step box then click Next.



You have now finished your first training and it is recommended that you use the tutorial.




Every time you use Dragon Naturally Speaking it is wise to Check your Audio settings.  
Click on Tools then Accuracy Center




