TITLE: Directed Learning Activity: SQ3R method

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOME (SLO): Student will be able to apply the SQ3R reading strategy to an article or chapter.

OBJECTIVE/PURPOSE: To increase reading comprehension and retention.

INSTRUCTIONS: First, the tutor should guide the student through the "how and why" of SQ3R. Next, the student should apply the SQ3R method to a short article, or portion of a chapter, from his/her own textbook. (A sample textbook or article can be used instead.) Student should fill in the attached worksheet to get accustomed to the method.
