Library Instruction

There are many ways we can provide library instruction and integrate library and information literacy skills into your courses! If you are interested in any of the options below, contact a librarian!

Synchronous Zoom Library Sessions

These can be brief orientations to library resources or longer sessions that are tailored to your specific assignment. If your class is asynchronous, we will work with you to find an option that works best for your students - this could be drop-in hours with a librarian or a scheduled day/time that works for your students.

Embedded Librarian

A librarian can be embedded into your Canvas courses by being added as a Collaborator in order to provide library and information literacy support for your students. Some examples of the support we can provide in this role include: moderating a discussion board, adding a library module to your course, or offering drop-in Zoom sessions. We will work with you to determine the best ways we can provide support as an embedded librarian.

Embedded Library Content

Content from the library, including articles or eBooks from databases, videos from our streaming services, videos from our YouTube channel, any of our Library Guides, and library Canvas modules in the Canvas Commons can be embedded into your Canvas courses. Book Delivery & Locker Pick-Up



We are now offering two options for checking out books from our Main Collection, Leisure Reading Collection, and Textbook Lending Library!

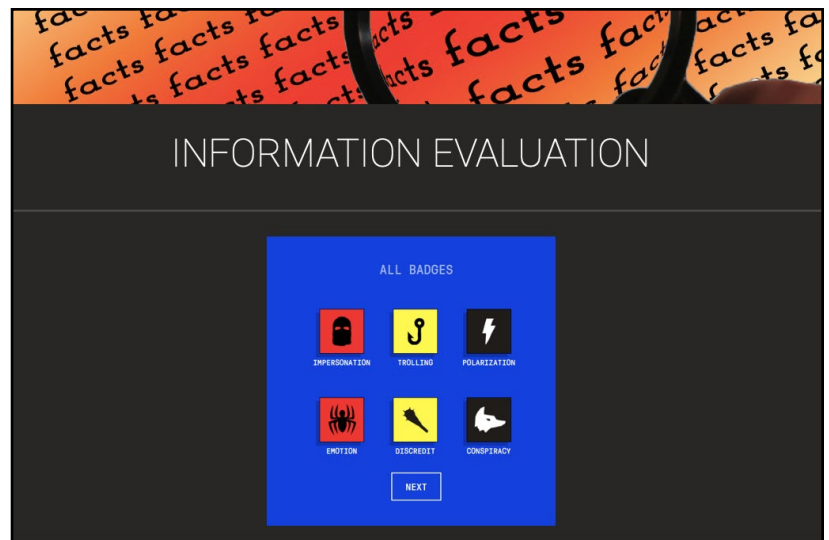
Using [OneSearch](#), you may now request books to either be delivered to your home or be placed in our new lockers for you to pick-up on campus. The lockers are conveniently located near the intersection of Campus Way and Estates Avenue and can be accessed 24/7. Home delivery requests are processed and shipped via USPS weekly.

Information Evaluation Workshop

Our [Information Evaluation Workshop](#) is an interactive one-hour workshop will prompt students to think critically about the information they encounter in their daily lives through news and social media, introduce them to tools and strategies to evaluate that information, and help them develop their information literacy skills.

The workshop includes content that is familiar to students and that they likely interact with on a daily basis, such as Tik Tok videos, tweets, and cable news stories. Librarians prompt students to take a closer look at this content and think critically about the content creators, the claims they make and utilize evaluation strategies and tools like the [Media Bias Chart](#).



In addition to hosting this workshop live on zoom, we also have a module in the Canvas Commons that you can add to your course for an asynchronous experience.

BOOK DELIVERY SERVICE



You can now use OneSearch to request books to be delivered right to your door!



Use OneSearch to search for your book title



Click on the book title and look for **Get It**



Click on **Request**, select **Home Address** from the drop-down menu, and then **Send**

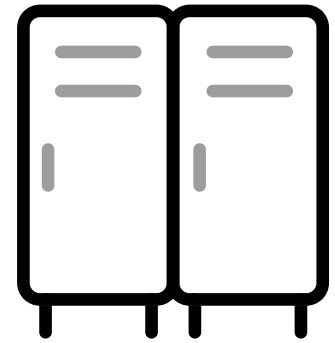
