Certificates of Achievement are designed to demonstrate that the student has completed coursework and developed capabilities relating to a career or general education.

- 1. Complete the major coursework**, a minimum of 18 units (or between 12 and 17.5 units in a low-unit certificate), prescribed in a State Chancellor's Office approved certificate of achievement. All course requirements specified.
- 2. Complete all applicable coursework** in a state approved Certificate of Achievement with no less than a "C" or "P" in each course.
- 3. Achieve a cumulative grade point average of no less than 2.0** in all applicable college coursework.
- 4. Complete at least 12 semester units in residence** at the college granting the certificate.
- 5. Apply for your Certificate.** The Certificate of Achievement is not automatically awarded when you complete the requirements. File an application by the established deadline for the Certificate of Achievement in the Counseling Office during the same semester in which you plan to finish the requirements.
