\*\*Please be aware that students with <u>ANY MISDEMEANOR OR FELONY</u> conviction within the past <u>SEVEN YEARS</u> will be denied placement at a clinical facility. A drug and alcohol screening will also be required before entry into the Nursing Program. Any positive result will be denied placement at a clinical facility. These will prevent entrance into the Ventura College Nursing Program.\*\*

**Highly Recommended Courses:** NS V07, Math V35, Bus V27A, Pathophysiology (offered at Moorpark College NS M25)

Courses noted with an asterisk \* can also be completed with a passing score of a 3, 4, or 5 on the required AP exam; or with the required passing score(s) on IB or CLEP exams.

Students will be cleared to schedule and take the TEAS exam at Ventura College once the student has submitted the Nursing Application to a Nursing Counselor (there is no charge to take the TEAS at VC)

## Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) EXAM

The TEAS is a required test for students submitting applications to the Ventura College Nursing program. The ATI TEAS measures basic essential skills in the academic content area domains of reading, mathematics, science and English and language usage. These entry level skills were deemed important for health science program applicants by a panel of subject matter experts.

Time limit is **209 minutes**. 170 multiple choice questions. A four-function calculator will be provided at the time of testing.
