Should I complete the FAFSA or the CA Dream Act?

FAFSA

- Be a U.S. citizen or Eligible Non-Citizen
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- If male, register with Selective Service
- Have a valid social security number

*If you have a Social Security Number issued by Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA), DO NOT apply for the FAFSA. <u>DO</u> apply for the CA DREAM ACT.

CA DREAM ACT

dream.csac.ca.gov

- Be an undocumented student
- Have a CA high school diploma or equivalent
- Have attended a CA high school for at least three years OR attained credits from a CA high school equivalent of at least three years of full-time high school coursework and attended a combination of elementary, middle and/or high schools in CA for a total of three or more years
- If male, register with Selective Service
- Confirm AB 540 eligibility with Admissions and Records.

The CA priority deadline to apply for the CA Dream Act each year is March 2nd.
