Streaming Service Changes

We unfortunately have to end our subscription to Hoopla on June 30, 2020. Hoopla and our IT worked tirelessly to attempt to connect Hoopla with our new cloud-based platform, Alma, in order to allow the VC community to authenticate and use Hoopla seamlessly; however, they were unable to make the connection work.

We know many in our VC community used Hoopla not just for leisure, but for course content. If there is something from Hoopla that you were using in your courses, please let us know and we can help find a solution for you.

Although we are losing this great service, we are adding two more new resources that will be available at the start of the fall semester!



OverDrive provides access to eBooks, audiobooks, and videos. You may be familiar with this as many public libraries offer it. Our access includes popular, leisure reading materials, as well as academic titles, videos, and foreign language materials.

Kanopy provides access to thousands of feature films and documentaries. Videos can easily be embedded into your Canvas courses.

Summer Session: Teaching & Learning with the Library

The library will be closed to the public during the summer sessions, but your library classified professionals and librarians will still be available to help! Our current plans for the summer are to continue to support students through live chat and email help. Check the <u>library website</u> on May 18 for Summer Library hours.

- Textbook Access: Students may access up to seven (7) free textbooks from <u>VitalSource</u> and from <u>RedShelf</u>. These services are currently available only through May 25. We are unsure if this date may be extended. We will keep our website updated with any new information. When the free access to VitalSource and RedShelf expires, we will remove this links from the VC Library website.
- **Library Instruction:** There are a few ways you can integrate library instruction into your Canvas courses. See our <u>Faculty Guide</u> for more details.
 - 1. **Library Canvas Modules**: There are several VC Library specific modules available in the Canvas Commons. We can also create custom modules, just contact us!
 - 2. **Embedded Librarians:** We can be embedded into your Canvas course through a discussion board or a drop-in help Zoom session.
 - 3. **Zoom Instruction:** We can host/record live library instruction through Zoom.
 - 4. Videos: We can record instruction session or videos to support your courses or assignments. Check out some of the videos we already have on our YouTube Channel.
- Helpful Handouts: We have created a few helpful handouts that outline free online resources that are available, as well as infographics that can help students with skills like evaluating information. These are attached to this newsletter and also available on our website.
