Program Review

Thanks to everyone who completed their program review! **93%** of reviews were submitted by the October 9 deadline. The college is now evaluating and prioritizing the **316 resource requests** that were submitted. The Vice Presidents will present their respective area's top priorities to the campus on **November 16th at 4:15pm in ASC 130**. All are welcome to attend. After these presentations, the requests will go to college committees for further discussion and prioritization. Then, they will go to the College President, and a final report-out will occur in March.

Community College Survey of Student Engagement


