Replacement sound system for the Performing Arts Center auditorium. The Yunker Auditorium sound system is broken. Due to age, it can be repaired with used parts, but that is a short term solution that disables several features. We are requesting to replace the version installed with the last batch of renovations with the most current version of the same system or one with similar capabilities.

At the time the Performing Arts Center underwent program review, the system was still operational.

The Yunker Auditorium is used by the entire campus as well as income sourcing rentals through the Civic Center. If we wait to replace it and the repairs fail, we could lose revenue from rentals and force cancellation or relocation of campus events, such as Pirate Days and All College Day, to locations with less social distancing opportunities if any are available. This would also result in additional incurred cost for performance work arounds with theatre department productions or potential cancellations due to performance space availability, a disservice to all students enrolled in the program.
