CONDUCTOR Ashley Walters* PROGRAM NOTES: Welcome! After several semesters of online and outdoor Symphony rehearsals and concerts we are excited to welcome you back to our beautiful hall. To celebrate this season we play music that celebrates new beginnings and fresh starts. The Chamber Orchestra will perform Haydn's beloved "Sunrise" quartet, which marries singing solo melodies that rise and rise with bright and charming fast passages. The group will also perform Borodin's string sextet, of which only two movements have survived. Then, the Ventura College Symphony Orchestra will present Dvořák's Ninth Symphony, "From the New World." The Bohemian composer wrote this popular work in 1893 while living in New York City.



Tonight's performance of the second movement is dedicated to honoring the memory of Jorgia Bordofsky (1942-2022). Jorgia was a mother of four, grandmother of twelve, LaMaze childbirth educator, a dear friend to many, a dispenser of knowledge, useful information, and wisdom, a supporter of the downtrodden, an advocate for social justice, and a freedom rider in her youth. She was also the sister of our own violinist, Annette Halpern. Jorgia's favorite composer was Dvořák and she particularly loved the ninth symphony. ~Ashley Walters
