<p>4. Faculty stipend to assist in Tech Review – O. Long</p>	<p><i>STIT 9916: "...updating curriculum in Banner, mapper, CIM, CAT, Degree Works, ASSIST up to 50 hours"</i></p> <p><i>Can we offer to faculty to incentivize getting needed updates?</i></p>

Possible Committee Goal for AY 22-23</p>	<p><i>If the district moves to a compressed calendar in Fall 2023, course without correct hours (total rather than weekly) will cause negative issues for the academic data specialists. This will affect courses where the hours haven't been updated and are still being offered. Also,</i></p>

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	<p>another chance to inactivate courses we don't offer to lessen the workload in completing this clean-up.</p> <p>Could a report be run to see the courses needing edits? These can be administrative changes if everything else on the course is in order.</p>
<p>6. GE Approval – M. Bowen (<i>in absentia</i>)</p>	<p>A procedure that documented in the curriculum handbook is that if a course is newly approved for CSU GE-Breadth or IGETC, and the AA/AS GE list has a comparable area, then the CC may (although is not obligated to) vote to approve that course for the comparable AA/AS GE area without first obtaining a recommendation from P&GE.</p> <p>I would like to invoke (<i>in absentia</i>) the alternative procedure at the first or second CC meeting this fall. The new courses ETHS V01/AES V71 and ETHS V02/AES V72 were both approved for CSU GE-Breadth area D (Social and Behavioral Sciences) and area F (Ethnic Studies), effective F22. These courses were not previously on the AA/AS GE list. I recommend that CC vote to add these courses to the AA/AS GE list, also effective F22 (this is slightly retroactive but there is historical precedent for this; see the 9/1/2020 CC minutes) in area B2 (Social/Behavioral Sciences) and area F (Ethnic/Gender Studies)</p> <p><i>*Note for Sarah – Follow up needed if approved at CC – see email</i></p>
<p>7. Ambiguous-Placement Programs in CAT</p>	<p>Example: New Holistic Health COA effective F22. Where to put it in CAT? In CIM it is listed under "Health Education" but there is a "Holistic Studies" Discipline in CAT (which houses the GE Pattern I and Holistic Health PA).</p> <p>Upcoming ACCT courses – will they move to "Accounting" in CAT along with the Accounting AS/COA? These are all currently under "Business".</p>
<p>8. Blanket inactivation proposal for V88/V89 courses?</p>	<p>Since there are no active CORs for these in CIM or Banner, they will disappear in CAT. Nothing would need to be done in CIM; it's just to acknowledge the catalog change.</p>
<p>9. Transferring GE approvals (stemmed from an email from MB concerning ART V02C/AES V67 – see information to the right)</p>	<p><i>* At the first CC meeting in the fall, one of the action items (probably under P&GE) needs to be to grandfather the local GE approvals in areas C1 and F from the previously inactivated course, along the lines of what we did for the ASL courses (i.e., transferring the old GE approvals from the SL courses). Alternatively, these could go through the full P&GE process if deemed preferable by the curriculum committee. Otherwise this course will not apply to the local GE list (because it is an F23 implementation, it will not appear in the GE list for the F22 catalog). The GE designation should be made effective F23 to match the course's official reactivation term.
