Kelly Wellman submitted retirement papers to be effective 12-31-21. I did not receive these until I returned from winter break on 01-03-22. She did not anticipate this early retirement but needed to do it for personal reasons.

Q17. Why is this request needed at this time (as opposed to going through the annual program review process)? Please describe how your program will be impacted if this request is not approved.

One of the three CJ full-time instructors, Richard Goff, retired in December of 2017. No replacement has been approved despite multiple program review requests. Now with Ms. Wellman's retirement, we are left with only one full-time faculty for the CJ Department. This department provides significant degrees and certificates for the college as well as the police academy. In 2020-2021, we awarded 169 degrees and certificates plus the credit and noncredit certificates for the police academy. The students need support and guidance. All of this work should not fall on one full-time faculty who is also serving as the Department Chair.
