Full-Time Faculty in Psychology to replace Mark Pauley

Q4. Why was this request not included in the annual program review process?

Mark Pauley submitted his retirement paperwork at the beginning of March 2022.

Q17. Why is this request needed at this time (as opposed to going through the annual program review process)? Please describe how your program will be impacted if this request is not approved.

The psychology discipline is already down one FT position (Winnie Rivera was a late retirement in Summer 2019 and we never filled that position). With Mark Pauley's retirement, the discipline is down 2 FT positions. With the development of a PACE option for the ADT in Psychology (the third most popular major in Fall 2021, with NS being #1 and BUS being #2), the enrollment demand cannot be met without at least one additional FT faculty member. Mark Pauley, and the other two FT faculty have been regularly asked to teach multiple sections of extra-large classes because we have not been able to staff additional CRNs with adjunct faculty, enrolling up to 80 students per CRN. Now that Mark is retiring, this will severely limit the number of available seats in PSY. In addition, our remaining two FT faculty members have clinical psychology backgrounds, rather than research; we depended on Mark to teach the Intro to Research class -- a very challenging and critical course for psychology majors, and a difficult class to staff adequately with adjunct faculty.
