Student Learning Outcomes (SLOs) Facilitator Opening

There are two SLO Faculty Facilitators each year with a portion of their teaching load reassigned for this purpose.

Purpose:

Facilitators lead the SLO/SUO processes, train faculty and staff, oversee Nuventive (Nuventive (TracDat)), and assist the campus in successfully completing SLO/SUO assessments.

Details

The activities of the SLO Facilitators include the following, which strongly contribute to substantive dialog about SLO/SUOs.

- Are lead members of the College Outcomes Group and, as such, provide insight and guidance in SLO/SUO processes
- Participate in professional development activities to stay up-to-date with SLO/SUO requirements and best practices
- Use Nuventive (TracDat)
- Monitor compliance by all departments and service units with SLO/SUO responsibilities
- Develop training programs and materials for faculty and staff
- Provide SLO/SUO workshops and training opportunities for faculty/staff throughout the year
- Provide training to individuals and/or departments continuously throughout the academic year, as requested by faculty and staff
- Provide Nuventive (TracDat) training and create user instructional handouts
- Hold "Bring Your Data Days" to assist faculty and staff in entering assessment data into Nuventive (TracDat) and guiding them in using the data for meaningful improvement in their departments
- Provide reports on SLO/SUO status to VPs, Department Chairs, and Deans
- Provide SLO/SUO data for accreditation reports
- Any other tasks that ensure successful SLO/SUO processes and data collection
