More events like this. The speakers welcomed and encouraged questions and it wasn't just an information dump.



Very interactive & engaging!

I enjoyed learning more about Teams, which I know is out there but has been kind of a black box to me. The features I would most be interested in would be file sharing (and configuring Teams to share only certain files with certain people), determining whether Teams has protective features for sharing Access database files (so that two people can't work concurrently on changing the same record and interfere with each other), and on creating and replying to messages (I can reply to other people's threads, but I still don't know how to initiate a thread). So I was glad to hear about all the bells-and-whistles features that were touched on during Thursday's session, but I would have preferred to focus on the basic file-sharing and messaging features, and how these tie in with One Drive and Sharepoint. It seems like we have three file-sharing systems (One Drive, Sharepoint, and Teams) and it's difficult to see how or whether they can interact with each other, and the relative advantages of each of these systems over the other.

I enjoyed the tone of the training, it was light-hearted but still informative.

Matt and Ali did a great job in organizing the workshop and making it interactive.

I learned a lot of tricks on how to use Team and am looking forward to learning more. Thank you DE3!


A more focused, slower-paced session covering just basic features (e.g., texting and file sharing) in a smaller group that would allow for more interaction and experimentation. Thursday's session went so quickly that I didn't fully hear or understand all the instructions and so was not able to try all the features. Part of the problem is that Zoom screen-share has a lag that makes it difficult to see what options or tabs the discussion leader is clicking on to access Team's various functions. This, coupled with the need to switch between Zoom and Teams, makes it difficult to try things in real time unless the pace is much slower. It's really helpful if the presenter can hover over each link that needs to be clicked for five to ten seconds to overcome the Zoom lag and allow time for attendees to ALT+TAB between Zoom and Teams to try things.
