To strengthen Board performance, Board Members participate in the Annual Board Evaluation according to the following process:

## Annual Evaluation (April 1 - March 30)

Results will be presented to Trustees during the Annual June Strategic Planning Meeting.

- Each January, the Board Chair will appoint two Trustees to serve on an Ad Hoc Board Evaluation Committee to review the process and survey instruments with the Chancellor and/or Chancellor's designee(s). Ad Hoc Committee members will report outcomes to the full Board in a regularly-scheduled Board meeting no later than May.
- A Board evaluation will be distributed annually to all Trustees in electronic format by the Chancellor's Office. Evaluations will be completed within seven days.
- Chancellor's Office staff will compile the results by listing the distribution of responses given for each question and providing a list of all comments.
- One Trustee from the Ad Hoc Board Self-Evaluation Committee (or Trustee Designee) will attend Consultation Council to participate in a discussion on survey findings.
- Chancellor's Office will compile the evaluation results into a Summary Report for review and discussion during the Board's Annual Planning Session. Findings will be used in developing future Board goals.

• All forms and documentation associated with the evaluations will be maintained in the Chancellor's Office.
