3. Explore opportunities to support increased enrollments in Kinesiology/health classes/programs in light of new legislation (AB 928).

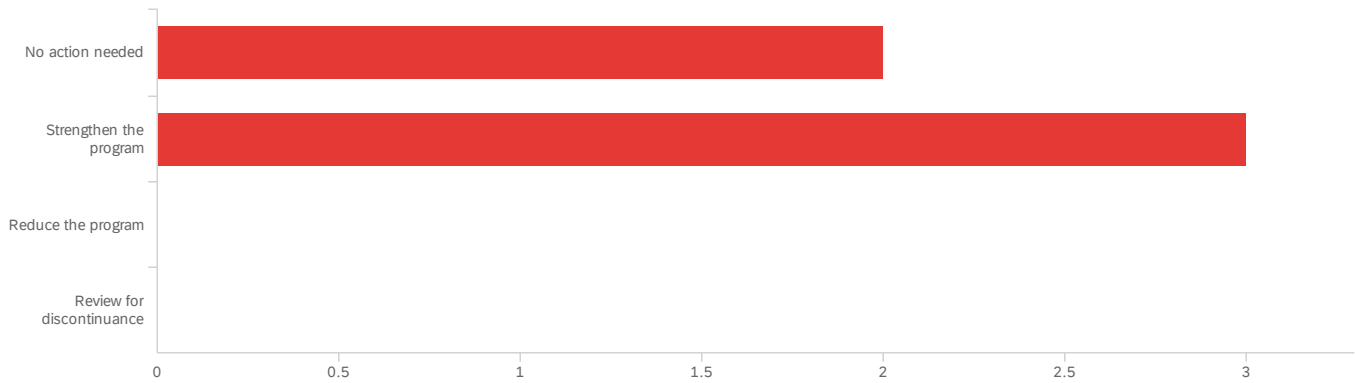
This program aligns with the objectives of the Master plan. The program prepares students well for transfer and the workforce.
