Dear Stacy Sloan-Graham,

Thank you for all the work you put into completing your comprehensive program review. It has been reviewed by the College Planning Committee and the Executive Team. The College Planning Committee feedback is attached. Below, you will find comments, commendations, and recommendations from the Executive Team. These are provided for incorporation into your annual program planning processes. Typically, recommendations require planning improvements that will be implemented over time. Thus, in your subsequent annual mini reviews, you will want to provide updates on progress made towards addressing these recommendations.

Comments:

- The VC Comm Studies program offers a transfer degree in Communication Studies. It is a comprehensive degree that can be applied to many workforce areas. The curriculum covers major areas of the discipline including public speaking, interpersonal comm, small group comm, argumentation & debate, intercultural comm, mass comm, oral interpretation, etc.
- The Communication Studies department actively follows VC's mission in placing students at the center of their learning experience, supporting them in achieving their personal, academic, and career goals in an antiracist, liberating, and inclusive environment. Faculty teach and support VC's diverse campus community and they lead students in achieving degrees, certificates, transfer.
- Despite the drop in enrollment during the pandemic, the major is growing, and with the coming demands of AB 928/CalGETC, the program anticipates more growth in the coming years.

Commendations:

- 1. The VC Comm Studies program has strong curricula, aligned with ADT requirements for Comm Studies.
- 2. As demonstrated by the course and program learning outcome data, students overall are achieving their goals and learning objectives in Communication Studies.

Recommendations:

- 1. Actively assess success and equity data to better understand where and how the department can increase outcomes post-pandemic.
- 2. Support opportunities to engage with professional development to improve student learning, including CVC/POCR, CCAR, Faculty Academy and the like.
- 3. Work with the VCEC Dean to offer more Dual Enrollment courses.
- 4. Work closely with the IE Dean and the VPAA to assess a relevant response to the demand of CalGETC in July 2025.

CPC's overall recommendation is **no action needed**, to which I concur. Thank you again for your dedicated work in improving outcomes for our students.


