3. ENGM V03L/V03R

On 08-08-23, Eric Martinsen and Jennifer Kagawa <u>confirmed</u> that these courses <u>should</u> offer students the option of Letter Graded or Pass/No Pass Grading. The courses are one level below ENGL V01A. → No action is required.

4. Internships – V95s/V96s

Effective **08-26-23**, Cooperative Work Experience (**CWE**, our internship courses, i.e., V95s/V96s) was renamed **Work Experience Education** (**WEE**), and:

1. The unit/hour relationship for **WEE** courses is **54 hours** per unit or "the equivalent locally determined minimum threshold for awarding one unit of credit", replacing the 60 or 75 hours-per-units for unpaid (V95) and paid (V96) courses, respectively.

 \rightarrow In the VCCCD, a unit of credit is equal to **52.5** hours of student learning.

§ 55253. College Credit, Attendance Accounting, Course Repetition (italics added)

(a) Units of credit for work experience education shall be calculated as follows:

(1)work experience education offered as a credit course: one semester unit of credit will be awarded for every 54 hours of work experience, or one quarter unit for every 33 hours of work experience, or the equivalent locally determined minimum threshold for awarding one unit of credit as codified in local board policy or procedure. Units of credit may be awarded in increments of .5 units; and

(2) work experience education integrated as a component of a course: units of credit will follow standards for credit hour calculations in section 55002.5 for all activity, lab, or other instructional course components. Units of credit for the work experience component shall be calculated according to the formula in subparagraph (1).

- Explicit repeatability for CWE courses has been <u>repealed</u>; WEE courses will only be repeatable if they meet one of the standards for repeatability that are enumerated in Title 5 section 55040.
- 3. The maximum units per <u>semester</u> allowed for enrollment in WEE courses is **14**; it was 8 for CWE.
- 4. Distinction between General Work Experience and Occupational Work Experience is being eliminated.
- 5. There are new standards for agreements between the district and employers.
