AES inactivation in favor of ETHS: Effect on CalGETC and Local GE</p>	<p><i>Discussion was had on motivation behind inactivating AES, and alternatively, what impact does this have to other disciplines, faculty load, student choice, should we wait until next Fall until hearing more from the state on common course numbering, etc</i></p> <p><i>Process on how and when to move forward discussed.</i></p> <p><i>Common Course Numbering AB1111 – going to wipe out some discipline prefixes like AES that are not state-wide. Will also include common articulation.</i></p> <p><i>Proposed timeline?
