Library Advisory Committee

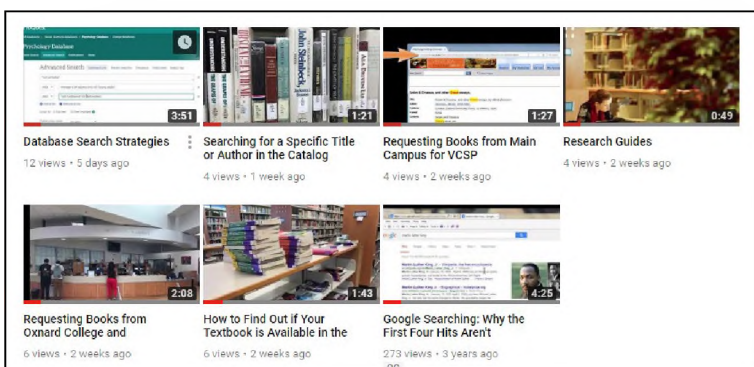

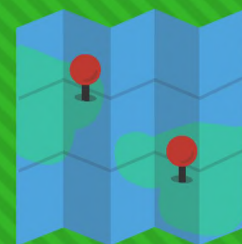

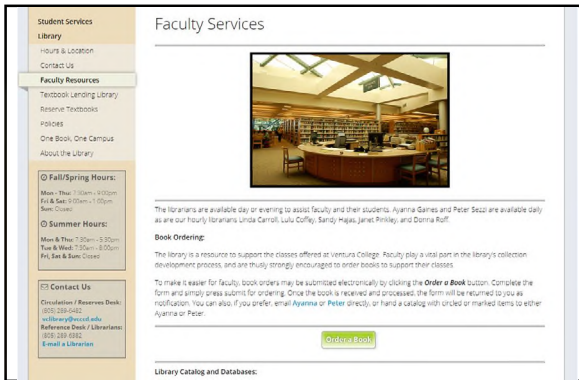

- Currently enrolled Ventura College students who will have completed 12 units at Ventura College by the end of fall 2017 (units at OC and SAC may not be counted towards Ventura College Foundation Scholarships)

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Complete all application questions online
 - Located under the "MyCollege" tab in "Student Quick Links" => "Scholarship Application"
- Submit copy of current transcripts
- 2 Letters of Recommendation
 - ✓ One letter should be from a VC instructor
 - ✓ The other may be from another instructor, or a supervisor/manager from volunteering or work
- 2 short essays: must be filed out in the application
 - ✓ Educational/Career goals
 - ✓ Community Service/Volunteering, Family Responsibilities, Extracurricular, School Activities, and Work Responsibilities

IMPORTANT DATES

- Application opens on November 1, 2017
- Application closes on January 31, 2018
