## Big Changes Coming Soon

The Council of Chief Librarians is embarking on a Library Services Platform project which will provide all California Community Colleges with a shared integrated library system.

What does that mean? By December 2019, the VC Library will have a one-stop online discovery system that allows students, faculty, and staff to:

- Search for VC Library books, ebooks, and articles all at once
- Search the collections off all participating CCCs and request titles to borrow

This project will result in some big changes to our library website and the way students, faculty, and staff will search for and access the information we need. As the project progresses, we will provide updates and plan to develop videos and other guides to help everyone navigate the changes.
