Dear Crystal Kallik,

Thank you for all the work you put into completing your comprehensive program review. It has been reviewed by the College Planning Committee and the Executive Team. The College Planning Committee feedback is attached. Below, you will find comments, commendations, and recommendations from the Executive Team. These are provided for incorporation into your annual program planning processes. Typically, recommendations require planning improvements that will be implemented over time. Thus, in your subsequent annual mini-reviews, you'll want to provide updates on progress made towards addressing these recommendations.

Comments:

- The program is made up of, Business, Accounting and Medical Assisting departments. Each of these areas prepares students for the workforce and offers certificates of completion and degrees in these fields.
- The Business AST is the third-highest awarded degree at the college.
- Enrollment has grown over the last five years but is still below its peak from 2020-21.

Commendations:

- 1. The resurgence of student interest in extra-curricular activities in the discipline.
- 2. The Department has a goal of increasing workplace learning opportunities in Accounting and Business programs.
- 3. The Program has recently updated the curriculum for its Bookkeeping degree and hired new fulltime faculty. This should help to revitalize this program.

Recommendations:

1. Although enrollments have grown over the past five years, they are still down slightly compared to their peak in 2020-21. The department is encouraged to continue to work to increase enrollment and explore offering relevant innovative business curriculum pathways. Hopefully, the newly hired full-time faculty member will help with this.

2. Develop support mechanisms for students and continue staff professional development to address course success rate gaps that are evident with the department's Black and Hispanic students.

CPC's overall recommendation is to sustain the program, to which I concur. Thank you again for your dedicated work in improving outcomes for our students.
