Ventura College School of Prehospital and Emergency Medicine CPR Card Requirements

All students must have a valid CPR card as a prerequisite for the EMT and Paramedic courses. This requirement is mandated by the California EMS Agency and listed as a program requirement under Title 22.

The State requires that all students be certified at a BLS provider level. The following courses meet this requirement:

- 1. American Heart Association BLS Provider
- 2. American Red Cross BLS for Healthcare Providers
- 3. American Red Cross CPR for the Professional Rescuer

The following classes DO NOT meet the requirements for CPR certification:

- 1. American Heart Association Heart Saver CPR or Heart Saver CPR/AED
- 2. American Red Cross Adult/Pediatric CPR/AED

If your CPR certification does not meet the course requirements, you will need to obtain a new CPR certification that does meet the requirements. Attached is a list of CPR course providers. Code 3 Life Support is very familiar with the EMT program requirements and a number of former students have their program easy to navigate. This list is provided as a courtesy. It is the student's responsibility to research each provider for course information, availability, cost, etc.
