It was included in program review and it was prioritized just shy of the top 5 requests.

Q17. Why is this request needed at this time (as opposed to going through the annual program review process)? Please describe how your program will be impacted if this request is not approved.

In the last 6 years besides a slight lull during the COVID-19 pandemic there has been consistent demand for Astronomy courses, but even then averaging fill rates in the 90th percentile. While there has been consistent demand there has been a opposite trajectory for the availability of instructors to teach these courses. We rely heavily on a dwindling part-time workforce (we lost two part-timers to full time positions or moving out of the area this past year). Astronomy courses have went from part-timer instruction at ~77% in Fall 2020 to 100% in Fall 2022. Physics and Astronomy have continually developing positive outcomes for our target demographic in our equity plan men of color and to continue on that trajectory we need quality instructors (we are consistently losing to full-time instruction or other type of work elsewhere in the state or in other states) committed to the support of our students and their able to respond to their needs. The sustainability of this program will be

harmed by us not hiring a full-time mostly in-person instructor to offset continued losses we anticipate within our current and future pools.
