

## Types of SLOs and SUOs

- Student Learning Outcomes 3 types:
  - 1. Course SLO (CSLO) knowledge, skills, abilities a student should have after completing a course.
    - a. All courses are required to have at least two CSLOs
    - b. Example:
      - i. CD V22 Develop behavioral support plans, based on assessments, for a toddler, preschooler, or early elementary school age child.
  - 2. Program SLO (PSLO) knowledge, skills, abilities a student should have after completing a specific degree or certificate.
    - a. All programs are required to have at least two PSLOs
    - b. PSLOs for similar degrees and certificates are often identical to each other.
    - c. Example:
      - i. Social Media Marketing Program Students will be able to combine the social media plan into a business marketing plan.
  - 3. Institutional/General Education SLO (ISLO) knowledge, skills, abilities that every student who leaves VC with a degree, certificate, or vocational training should have.
    - a. VC has five ISLOs
      - i. Communication
      - ii. Scientific and Quantitative Reasoning
      - iii. Critical Thinking and Problem Solving
      - iv. Information Literacy
      - v. Personal/Community Awareness and Academic/Career Responsibilities
- Service Unit Outcome (SUO) student and administrative services what a client (student or employee) will experience, receive, or know as a result of a given service.
  - All services are required to have at least two SUOs
    - 1. Example:
      - University Transfer Center: Students will evaluate types of general education available and select two types of transfer patterns.
- Institutional Service Unit Outcome broad service support goals that are shared across campus. These are the outcomes of every service unit on campus in terms of how they support students.
  - VC has two ISUOs:
    - 1. The Service will support or facilitate a positive learning or service environment for students.
    - 2. The Service will support or facilitate institutional accountability by monitoring and ensuring compliance with statutory mandates, local policy and procedures, and state or federal law.
