Welcome to the imaginatively eerie world of *The Edgar Allan Poe Afterlife Radio Hour.* Set in the afterlife's decidedly vintage radio studio, this darkly comedic production brings the master of the macabre himself back from the grave and reimagines Poe's haunting tales and turbulent life as a broadcast like no other – equal parts spine-tingling, hilarious, and heartfelt.

As Poe grapples with his legacy and the ghosts of his own stories, he finds himself reluctantly hosting a supernatural radio hour, assisted (and heckled) by a chorus of ghoulish characters. The play weaves together classic Poe works – such as *The Tell-Tale Heart, The Raven,* and *The Fall of the House of Usher* – with unexpected humor, all while exploring the thin line between genius and madness.

Through the stylized chaos of the broadcast, Poe confronts questions of artistic purpose, fame, and the human need for redemption. Each tale becomes a mirror reflecting his fears and desires, ultimately guiding him toward a new understanding of himself – and of the strange afterlife he now inhabits.
