New Emergency Notification System

- Phase 1: Student Notification
 - If there is an incident: automatically inform students
 - Mobile app
 - In classrooms with desktop shortcut: click so professor can get help
 - Different tests on the system
 - Finished by this November
- Phase 2: Hardware
 - Common areas and classrooms: clocks and speakers from ceilings and wall
 - Everyone will be able to hear, be protected, and informed
 - The announcements will be in English and Spanish
 - The design layout is being worked on
 - How long to pause
 - How many times a message will be repeated
 - Message is typed across the devices with strobe lights
 - Wiring
 - By graduation – close to finishing
 - Initial training with employees in November
